# **Director's Report:**

#### Operations:

- Last month I updated you on the leadership situation at the Washington DC VA Medical Center regarding the appointment of the 4<sup>th</sup> Acting Interim Director. An announcement on the new director is imminent.
  - o There have been some other issues and I am monitoring them closely.
- Closed out the fiscal year
- VetsRide is up and running in FY 19
  - Some programming tweaks:
    - Only one round trip per day
  - Over 270 veterans enrolled in the program
- We now have bi-monthly table hours at the VA medical center
- Exploring weekly hours at the CRRC
- Ward 6 fire displaced some members of the veteran community. MOVA worked with veterans, DHS, Red Cross to coordinate and deliver replacement medications from the VA Medical Center. Support is on-going.
  - American Legion Post 8 on Capitol Hill held a fundraiser and has been connecting with those veterans to provide assistance
- Hosted the Mental Health Summit
- Hotel Association & Veteran Employment panel
- 2 Voc Rehab Clinics
- 3 Claims Clinics
- 7 VetsRide sign up events

- New Veteran Service Officer has been identified
